What is a CSA? It stands for Community Supported Agriculture and it represents a beautiful relationship where the farmers know who they are feeding and the customers know the farmer! Customers are more than just consumers—they are members of the CSA who commit to supporting the local farm by buying a share of vegetables at the start of the season. Then, each week throughout the season, the members come to the farm and get their share of vegetables that were harvested that week! We hope to begin harvesting mid-May and the CSA lasts 15 to 22 weeks, depending on the weather.

Large share	recommended for a family	\$750 for the season
Medium share	recommended for a couple	\$425 for the season
Small share	recommended for singles	\$250 for the season
