### **A Note from the Principal's Desk...**

Dear Parents,

Every February, Americans celebrate **Black History Month**. This tribute dates back to 1926 and is credited to a Harvard scholar named Carter G. Woodson, Ph.D. The son of former slaves, Dr. Woodson was the second African American to receive a doctoral degree from Harvard University. **Dr. Woodson dedicated his life to ensuring that black history was accurately documented and disseminated**, and he worked vigorously to establish Black History Month.

The month of February was chosen by Dr. Woodson to honor the birth months of abolitionist Frederick Douglas and President Abraham Lincoln. I encourage you to **talk to your children about the accomplishments of black Americans**, especially those like Madame CJ Walker and Matthew Henson, whose contributions are often overlooked.
